SNAP® is a juvenile delinquency prevention program that helps children and parents deal effectively with anger by teaching them how to respond in a way that makes their problems smaller, not bigger. The Family Worker provides services to families and conducts parent group sessions.

The position requires a Bachelor Degree in a related field. Familiarity with cognitive behavior therapy, structured group and parent education and one year experience working with children and families preferred. Community liaison experience is recommended. This position requires a valid driver's license, vehicle and proof of insurance. Required to apply for Act 33/34 clearances (criminal and child abuse) as well as FBI clearance. Pre-employment drug screening and random employment drug testing required. This position requires working a flexible schedule including evenings.
