HARTMAN MALE SHELTER



The Hartman Male Shelter (HMS) is a Shelter Stabilization and Detention Diversion Program located at Auberle in McKeesport, Pennsylvania. HMS provides 24 beds in a safe, structured environment for boys ages 12-18 who are exhibiting behavioral issues or are in conflict with law enforcement.

HMS offers residents opportunities to get back on track through supportive programming. HMS staff is trained in trauma-informed care and therapeutic crisis intervention. Auberle provides HMS residents with on-site education, behavioral health services and access to Auberle's Employment Institute. Our program has received accolades from counties and continuously monitors the quality of programming.



SERVICES AVAILABLE

TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE

Auberle understands the impact of trauma on young people and how it can lead to poor choices. We help them to move forward in spite of it and encourage them to make better decisions in the future. Daily group work utilizing the "Thinking Errors" and "Negative Powers Acts" curriculums allows growth and change to happen.

EDUCATION

Auberle strives to provide quality, individualized education to each HMS resident. The Allegheny Intermediate Unit provides on-site classes to HMS residents. In addition, Auberle's Learning Innovation Coordinator provides residents with the opportunity to participate in yearround STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) programming.

CRISIS-INTERVENTION

Auberle staff is equipped to deal with crisis-intervention and possess the tools to help HMS residents make better choices in the midst of trauma and instability.

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
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Admissions

Admissions are accepted from county probation systems for preadjudication and sanctions, child welfare stabilization and direct admits from law enforcement for non-violent offenders.

Restitution

HMS residents can earn restitution during their stay by performing community service in the form of cleaning the residents' rooms and shared living space.



SERVICES AVAILABLE

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

HMS residents have access to a variety of behavioral health services from Auberle's team of skilled, clinical therapists. Service areas include mental health, drug and alcohol, trauma, behavioral disorders, anger management and arson prevention.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

HMS residents have access to Auberle's Employment Institute, an award-wining workforce development program.

Residents can participate in sessions that teach work ethic, job-readiness and digital literacy and have the opportunity to learn more about career certification programs available through the Employment Institute.

PREVENTION

A key objective of all of Auberle's programs is to teach work ethic to the young people we serve. We provide them with the resources necessary to make positive choices and avoid involvement in the justice system, and lead healthy, stable and independent lives.
